



First Lieutenant Patrick C. "Clebe" McClary III, USMC (Retired)

During the Vietnam War, this Lowcountry native was serving as a platoon leader in the First Reconnaissance Battalion. On the battalion's 19th patrol, the unit was attacked by the Viet Cong. Lieutenant McClary was seriously wounded, losing his left arm and left eye, yet he continued to lead his men. He faced his rehabilitation with characteristic determination. In the years since, Lieutenant McClary has become a symbol of courage and hope to the many audiences around the world with whom he has shared his story.
